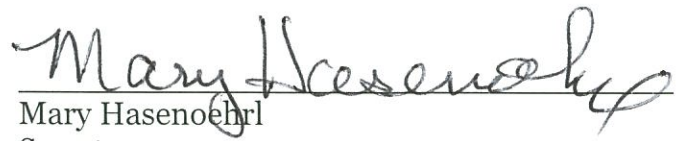
**ACTIVE AGENDA:**

The Port Commission examined revisions to the Minutes for Special Meeting of January 8, 2015. After discussion, Commissioner Hasenoehrl made a motion to accept the revised Minutes as presented; seconded by Commissioner Klemm. The motion passed unanimously.

Review and consider for approval an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for Telecommunication Facilities with the Port of Whitman County for services supporting a fiber optic network. Port Manager, David Doeringsfeld, reported that he was pleased to report that all the revisions discussed collectively at the previous meeting have been incorporated by the Port's attorney into the document for consideration. Review and discussion of the revisions included, but not limited to, maintaining industry service standards, revenue and expense responsibilities as the network expands and timelines. Tom Callery, the Port's attorney, in attendance stated that he was pleased with the revisions. Manager Doeringsfeld complimented the assistance and professionalism by the representatives from the Port of Whitman County. After discussion, Commissioner Hasenoehrl made a motion to approve the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for Telecommunication Facilities with the Port of Whitman County for services supporting a fiber optic network; seconded by Commissioner

Klemm. The motion passed unanimously. Each Commissioner commented favorably on the benefit of the project to the community.
