LOWERING OF LOWER GRANITE LAKE

Corps of Engineer personnel are installing a fishing platform at Evans Pond, near Clarkston Washington, for public ADA access. This work, requiring a drawdown of the Lower Granite Pool (Lower Granite Lake), will be performed commensurate with the Walla Walla District Navigation Lock Maintenance Outage. This work is not expected to affect commercial river users.

The drawdown will reduce water elevations from the current minimum maintained elevation of Minimum Operating Pool + 2 feet (elevation 735 at the Lower Granite forebay). From 7 March through 22 March 2020, the Lower Granite pool will generally operate between elevation 733 to 734 feet (NGVD 29 datum).

River users are cautioned to observe river conditions for shoaling during this period since river levels are expected to be approximately 2-5 feet lower than present conditions.
